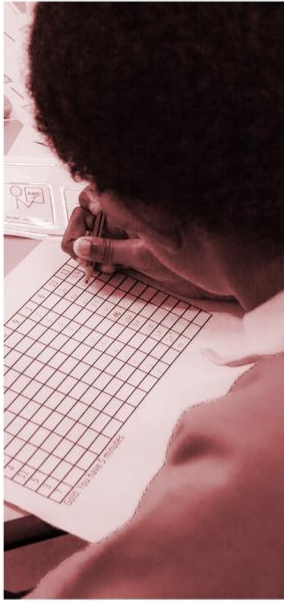


Year 7 Catch Up Grant

September 2020



The school is eligible to receive the Year 7 catch-up premium. This gives state-funded schools, including special schools and alternative provision settings, additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve the expected standard in reading or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2).
