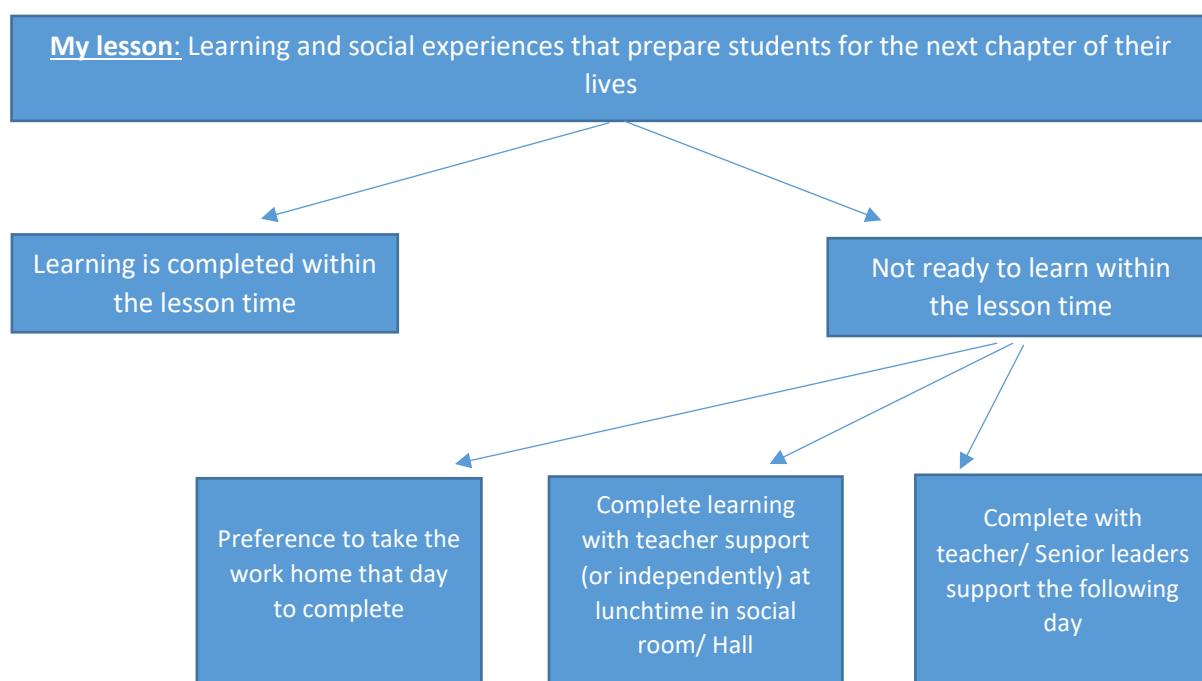


'Keep up - Catch up' strategy at Fen Rivers Academy

We believe that giving all our students agency is an important process in our students *learning for themselves*. Students have the choice to complete work supported by staff at lunchtime, or if they feel they need fresh air and time outside for lunch (social time), are expected to catch up missed learning in their own time and work is sent home. This is to avoid them falling behind with their education. Students have exams in Year 11 and we provide the opportunity to catch up lost learning so dysregulated behaviours do not affect their future life chances. Adults give their own time at lunch time to support this as it is, of course, a core value which we are here to encourage. Through agency and choice, children learn for themselves and appreciate being treated like adults, but without losing focus on their education being at the core of our school experience.
