

Theatre Royal Norwich Trip

Teachers and children will travel together on the bus to Norwich.


When we are on the bus, we will stay in our seats.

The bus will drop us off at the Theatre Royal








We will go into the theatre.

There will be other people in their seats too. We will be able to see the stage.




We will sit in our seats and wait for Charlie and the Chocolate Factory to start.

We will watch Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.






If we need the toilet when we are watching Charlie and the Chocolate Factory, a member of staff will take us to the toilet.

Mrs Fewkes and Miss Good will take us outside to the break out space and help us to feel better.




When Charlie and the Chocolate Factory has been on for one hour, Charlie and the Chocolate Factory will have an interval.

In the interval, our teachers will give us a snack and a drink.


We can use the toilet in the interval.
