



Our School Improvement Focus this week: Wellbeing

This week the pupils have been working hard on column subtraction in Koalas class; moving from 3 digit to 5 digit numbers (and beyond)! We learnt how to start with the units and re-group tens, hundreds and thousands to make the subtraction work!



In English, Koala's have been learning about Friendship. We thought about the ingredients needed for friendship and made, and wrote, a friendship recipe. We have also talked about lesson conflict and the importance of compromising with others.



The children learnt about the solar system; naming the planets and researching information about them.

In all classes pupils have been collecting 3Ps points, reflecting our 3Ps values around People, Place and Purpose. For each learning session there is the opportunity to collect a point for each of the 3Ps, for being in the right place, at the right time, focusing on things in the right way. This enables them to reflect with their class staff on the positives in every day and helps us to spot patterns and unpick challenges the children experience in learning each day and over time.


