Hedgehogs wanted to try out some wild camping in the forest area and used their survival skills to build a tent.




They also made a seesaw. Great balance and core stability needed for this activity.


Next for Tigers came learning about sexual and asexual plants. They sorted them into the different types and then planted some of their own to grow in our new garden area.
