






This week in Geography, Koalas have been learning about America.

In the session we learnt about the American flag and what the stars and stripes represent.

Koalas found out that there are 50 stars but 52 states. They also found out that the flag had a union jack on it.

The children used their imagination to design an object.

Clay is a brilliant resource to help develop children's fine motor skills as they pinch, squeeze and shape the clay.

We found out how many minutes there are in an hour, we have been counting in 5, 10 and 15 minute intervals and we have learnt to recognise past and to the hour on a clock face.






