## Introduction

The PE and Sport Premium is additional funding for schools intended to ensure sustainable impact in pupils' participation and attainment in PE and sport. The premium is also used to:

- Develop or add to the physical and sports activities that The Bridge Integrated Learning Space already offer.
- Build capacity and capability within The ILS to ensure that improvements made now will benefit pupils joining the school in future years.

## Funding 2023-2024

The Bridge Integrated Learning Space received £2,000.

## Impact

Our grant has continued to contribute towards enhancing our access to community by supporting us to maintain our minibus and car which are critical for getting students out to local parks and events. We are really pleased that we have seen an increase in pupil access to the community for sports (football/pedal power/ swimming) as well as other cultural events by joining the Islington 11 / 11 initiative which aims to give all young people access to cultural events in their communities. We have also been working closely with the Arsenal Hub and seeking to forge more links with other community organisations. We will continue to have a targeted focus on these areas for the coming year as physical and emotional wellbeing are a core priority of our work at the ILS.

## Swimming

Due to pupils' cognitive and physical needs, the number of pupils in Year 6 who have met all the below national curriculum requirement is zero:

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively – for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations
